If you want them for full time, part time or just occasionally, John Weygang Optometrist can advise you on the right lenses. The Ascend range offers a comprehensive choice of lens types to suit your needs.

**Ascend 1 Day Disposables** offer comfortable all day wear when you want it. No solutions, no cleaning, no inconvenience – just discard when finished. Available in 30 or 90 packs, toric lenses to correct astigmatism and an 'One Day Comfort' lens for people with dryer eyes.



**Ascend Monthly Lenses** are made in an Aspheric design for maximum comfort and vision. This lens is replaced each month and uses a simple 'rub & rinse' procedure at the end of each wearing day. Designed for use most days or every day using this lens is an affordable yet comfortable lens.

**Ascend Plus** is made of a biocompatible material designed to mimic the body's own building blocks. This lens deposits and dries less easily than standard materials to maintain its comfort right through the day. The same material used for the Ascend 1 Day Comfort.

**Ascend Torics** are used to correct a wide range of astigmatism, a distortion of the eye commonly found in many spectacle wearers. The Ascend Toric is designed to give comfortable and stable vision in a monthly disposable format.

**Ascend Premier** is the most advanced of the Ascend range. It is made of a Silicone Hydrogel material designed to give much higher Oxygen permeability and water content. This is important in maintaining good health and comfort for the eyes, especially if lenses are worn for longer periods or for overnight use.

**Coloured Contact Lenses** to change the way you look are also available. Designed in a monthly format but can be stored in an appropriate solution for intermittent use.

**Gas Permeable Hard Lenses** are less frequently used than the more initially comfortable soft lenses, but still can be beneficial in certain circumstances such as high degrees of astigmatism.

**Varifocal Contact Lenses** can be used by people who would otherwise need two pairs of glasses or Varifocal spectacles. They are available as Soft or Hard Gas permeable lenses.

## How can I find out if contact lenses will suit me?

- The fitting procedure is simple. Following an eye examination and a discussion of your needs and requirements, the best type of lenses to suit you is decided. This will take into account choices such as: occasional or full time use, overnight use, if you have astigmatism or if you need varifocal lenses.
- You are then taught how to insert, remove, handle and care for your lenses. The lenses are assessed in your eyes and the vision checked.
- Following a trial period you are asked to return and the lenses re-assessed. If you are happy with the lenses, and if they are clinically suitable, then you can be registered for future supply. The fitting procedure, trial lenses and solutions are free of charge if booked with a sight test.
- Charges for your lenses can either be with a convenient monthly direct debit, which includes lenses, solutions and aftercare. Or you can pay for products as you need them. Regular aftercare check-ups will usually be needed on a yearly or twice yearly basis.
